## Getting on Track

- Expresses interest in church planting/campus pastoring to Campus Pastor
- Meeting with Leadership Pastor (Jim Egli)
- Moving forward at the appropriate level outlined below

## Growing Disciple

1. Takes Beginnings & Becomes a Vineyard Member
2. Kingdom Healing 1
3. Tithing
4. Involved in a Small Group and serving as leader apprentice in that group or as an apprentice leader in a Vineyard ministry (SGL training completed)
5. Effectively sharing Christ with friends, relatives and associates

## Growing Leader

6. Leads growing Vineyard Small Group or Ministry & multiplies their leadership
7. Reads *Doing Church* book or takes the *Doing Church* VBI course
8. Participates in an Encounter God Retreat or Healing Journey
9. Reads *Breakthrough* book or take the *Kingdom 1* VBI course
10. Takes the online Church Planters Assessment at their own expense of \$29 at:

  - 10.1. Meets with Leadership Pastor to Discuss Next Steps
11. Begins Attending Church Planters Bootcamps – Offered twice a year (August/September & February)

- 11.1. Discovery (This one is offered at every boot camp)
- 11.2. Gathering & Training Your Team
- 11.3. Developing a 2-Year Plan
12. Continuing to lead friends, neighbors, relatives and associates to Christ and disciple them in Christian life.

## **Growing Leader of Leaders**

13. Begins working on 2-year plan
  14. Takes *Teaching to Transform Lives* Course
  15. Takes *Preaching for a Change* Course
  16. SLT approval for Vineyard pastoral assessment interview
  17. Church Planter Pastoral Assessment (Previous Steps Required)
  18. Meeting with Senior Pastor (Happy) for input and approval
    - If planting outside our region (or country), communication with and commendation to other region (or mission partnership) is needed here
  19. Begins working on issues flagged in Church Planters Assessment
    - Optional: Pastoral Internship
  20. Percept demographic study ordered for target community
  21. 2-year plan completed and reviewed with Leadership Pastor and Senior Pastor (Previous Steps Required)
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22. Prayer team recruited
  23. Gathers a committed church planting/campus team
  24. Continues attending church planting bootcamps together with potential and committed church planting team members.
  25. Church planters start a small group with church plant team in final 9-12 months
  26. Replaces themselves in current ministry roles
  27. Commissioning of church planter/campus pastor and team (Previous Steps Required)

There is some flexibility in the order of these steps but all of them are necessary and certain steps require the completion of the previous steps.
